At Crawley, October 31st

Just Reward For Sandra Marquis

THE second Greater London League held at Crawley last Saturday, was through Tilgate Forest and the ground, although firm, was made slippery by the rain. The home club had originally planned to have the start in the grounds of the school where the changing accommodation was situated. However, due to work for a pipe line being started within the last ten days the original course had to be abandoned and rather than cancel the fixture a new course was hurriedly marked out.

In the first race Betty Price (Uxbridge) repeated her win of the first League Intermediate race but this time from Linda Salmon (Ryde), while Julie Vancuylenberg (Croydon) was again third.

In the senior race Sandra Marquis (Watford), a first year senior, was always to the fore and ran out a comfortable winner from Penny Yule (Brighton). Beryl Bush, also of Brighton and Hove, this time was third but now leads the individual points score. Cambridge packed 5 in 25 in the team competition but even this was not good enough to beat the young Watford team.

So, after a few seasons in the shadow of Mary Sonner, Sandra has emerged in her own right and it was a just reward for her admirable consistency. Mary finished 11th but has only just recovered from 'flu and at this stage is not forcing herself unduly. As for Penny Yule (21), she surprised even herself with this performance, in which on the long uphill climb to the finish she found herself passing girl after girl and finally went by her more illustrious team-mate 50 yards out. Penny was expecting "no better than tenth".

Margaret MacSherry, winner of the last four League races (one this year and all three last year) dropped right back at one point but really motored in the closing stages to get back up to fifth.

The previous Junior race at Thurrock had provided a record field of 188 finishers but that record was short lived when 235 finished in this second race of the season. Christina Boxer (Aldershot) and Lesley Kiernan (Havering) renewed the rivalry at the head of the field with the Aldershot girl having the edge, while Regina Joyce of the next club took 3rd place from her 12-year-old sister Monica. Newcomers to the League, Havering, again took the Junior team race from Thurrock.

The third and final races in the series take place at Sherrards Wool Park, Welwyn Garden City, on November 28th.

LEAGUE RACES

METROPOLITAN LEAGUE At Greenford, November 21st

HILLINGDON ATHLETIC CLUB scored their 14th consecutive victory this season, in the Metropolitan League cross country and increased their lead over the holders TVH by another 157 points. In this Senior meeting at Greenford the home club Ealing excelled themselves on their course, scoring a mere 60 points less than Hillingdon, for second place. 26 year old Mathematical Computer Trainer, Tony Moore of Hillingdon went ahead shortly after the start, over the flatish fast first 2 laps but on the second of the 2 final laps of the 4 lap race, Verlea's Mills was overtaken by Stewart Buchanan who went on to move ahead of the pursuing group up the final steep hill and take second place.

The youth's 2 1/2 mile race was held just before the Senior race and the last Met. League winner John Davies of TVH was soon prominent, but at the end of the first lap Shaftesbury's Julian Goater, 3,000m world age record holder (17 years), was a stride ahead of the shorter Davies who was hanging on to the pace. Julian moved away on the last hill to come home 6 seconds clear of Davies and the other 60 finishers. After the race Julian explained "I have only been able to do 4 to 5 miles a day of training because of a hip injury which seems a bit better now."
